

MISSION PROGRAMS (September 2020)

Purpose

To affirm the Lord's call to "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all people."
To encourage mission awareness on all levels --- local/state, national/international.
To support missions both financially and in personal involvement.

Mission Organizations

Mission organizations are provided for each age group:

- Baptist Men
- Women's Missionary Union

Directors for each group serve a one-year term, are recommended by the Nominating Committee, and elected by the Church.

Responsibilities

- Encourage mission awareness within the church and promote participation in missions through programs and activities
- Affirm church's commitment to support local, national, and world missions through budget and special offerings --- Lottie Moon, Annie Armstrong, Homes/Hospitals, NC State Missions, etc.
- Encourage and support the development of children's and youth missions activities.
- Identify mission opportunities.
- Emphasize the importance of prayer, financial support, and direct involvement in missions.
- Submits budget request annually to the Stewardship Committee.

Mission Projects

The church recognizes the value in direct mission involvement by church members, and seeks to enable various mission projects/trips. All church mission projects/trips that require church funding must be reviewed by staff and lay leadership, and approved by the Church.

- Projects/Trip must demonstrate a clear spiritual ministry perspective.
- Must have clear expectations and requirements of those who participate.
- Must have financial plan for funding.
- Must identify other local churches/organizations with which project may be coordinated.
